VINEYARDS: 'Noirots' sits just to the east of grand cru Bonnes Mares, facing east/southeast. Soils mix rocky limestone with rich clay. The lieu-dit name evokes the French word "noyers," walnut trees; the land was probably once an orchard.

AGE OF VINES: 40+ years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Partially destemmed; fermented on indigenous yeasts in cement tank. Aged in French oak barrels (20% new). Bottled unfined and unfiltered, according to the lunar cycle.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of red and black fruits, light spices, licorice. Medium-bodied and concentrated; yet also good freshness, lively

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Autumn flavors, such as pork roast with chestnuts,

wild mushrooms
