VINEYARDS: 'Blanchards' faces east in the heart of Morey, in a moderate depression that was once the path of an ancient river. Soils are rich and deep, with decomposed limestone, almost alluvial. 'Blanchards' refers loosely to a type of white-colored (in French, blanche), limestone-rich soil.

AGE OF VINES: 40+ years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Partially destemmed; fermented on indigenous yeasts in cement tank. Aged in French oak barrels (20% new). Bottled unfined and unfiltered, according to the lunar cycle.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of red and black fruits, light spices, licorice. Medium-bodied and concentrated; yet also good freshness, lively

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Autumn flavors, such as pork roast with chestnuts, wild mushrooms
