

DOMAINE BAROLET-PERNOTSaint-Romain Blanc 'Sous le Château'

Saint-Romain is a Burgundy insider's secret, a village shaped like a sunny amphitheater that is hidden behind a series of higher hills in the Côte de Beaune. Fourth-generation grower Romain Barolet-Pernot in a few short years has turned his family domaine into an up-and-coming star. Bringing back their best grapes (previously sold to Olivier Leflaive) and taking a more organic approach in the fields, Romain has transformed these small-batch wines to reflect his home village's stony energy and high-altitude freshness like a polished mirror.

VINEYARDS: 'Sous le Château' is Saint-Romain's top vineyard, a perfect plot on a very steep slope that faces mostly east/southeast on white, stony,

limestone-rich soils.

AGE OF VINES: 30 years, on average

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Full-cluster press; juice filtered by gravity. Fermented in stainless steel tanks on indigenous yeasts. Aged in older French oak cask and tank for 11 months.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of grapefruit and lemon zest, fresh ginger,

crushed stones, white fruit. Medium-bodied, suave, long

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: As an aperitif; with fresh cow's cheese; spring

salads; grilled chicken
